- Recognize, assess, and respond appropriately to camper concerns and situations. Use positive behavior management techniques as modeled and practiced. Offer support and guidance as needed.
- Provide attentive supervision during assigned activities keeping the safety of campers as the first concern.
- Be an exemplary role model for campers by exhibiting an upbeat, positive and friendly attitude
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the camp program, including knowing the whereabouts of your charges at all times
- Prepare for and actively participate in all aspects of camp. Be punctual, come prepared and be a supportive team player.
- Be a problem–solver, but ask for help when necessary
